

17. DIRECTIONS TO THE SITE

From Westbound I-90 through Cleveland take Exit 171 and follow signs for Abbey Avenue/West 14th Street. Turn left onto West 15th Street, then turn immediately left onto Abbey Avenue. Turn right onto Columbus Road and continue over Columbus Road Bridge. Arrive at project site at 1831 -1853 Columbus Road on the right.

18. Nature of Activity (Description of project, include all features)

Construction of 520 linear feet of new floating dock along the existing steel sheet pile bulkhead. The dock will be 10 feet wide and will be anchored with 7 new 40-foot long, 6-inch diameter steel pipe piles spaced at 75 feet on center along the existing bulkhead. The dock will be access by 5-foot wide by 20-foot long aluminum ramps connected to the existing bulkhead with 3 new 5-foot wide steel platforms. The platforms will be supported by new W8x35 piles and will be framed with W8x25 and C8x11.5 steel beams with 3/8-inch thick steel galvanized steel decking.

To construct a new rowing facility to provide for the launching and retrieval of rowing sculls.
